Approval of Minutes:

Interim Rector Report: Rev. Coleen Tully

Mother Coleen was asked about having a once-a-month Recovery Church Service. Eucharist would be given with water and unfermented grape juice. A day of the week or time has not been decided on yet.

John and Jan Gamble have requested spots in our Column Barium, and Mother Coleen asked if the Vestry thought we could just give them the spots or give them a discount due to their Service to the church. Rob made a motion to give John and Jan Gamble spots in the Column Barium without charge, all agreed.

Philadelphia 11 movie. The Philadelphia 11 were the first women to be ordained in the Episcopal church. A documentary was done on it. It will be shown at Iona Hope on February 21, 2024. Mother Coleen will get us the time.

Believe Out Loud. We are a Believe Out Loud Congregation. There are only 4 in the state of Florida. Patrick Hunt sent a list of places he felt the Church could advertise that we are a Believe Out Loud Church. We are showing a loss due to having repair and maintenance costs of \$107,000. We still have \$12,000 remaining on the Air Conditioner, but we will put that off until January.

The good news is thanks to Steve and all the Vestry, we are way ahead in Pledging than we have ever been. We have \$263,900 pledged so far.
