Scharf has received the required majority of consents in the canonical consent process detailed in Canon III.11.3. The consents received have been certified by the Rev. Canon Michael Barlowe, Registrar of the General Convention.

Scharf was elected bishop coadjutor on April 2. His consecration and ordination service is scheduled for Sept. 24.
