**Store Report: Eileen Carrara** 

Sales are doing great! They have done more sales in the first 5 months of this year than the entire last year. They are concerned about things slowing down, however. Eileen is looking for new ways to promote the store. They have only received 8 requests for grants so far, so Eileen is extending the deadline until June 2. The Thrift Store would like to extend their outreach. They have learned that Indigenous Americans in South Dakota are in dire need of warm clothing. In particular the Crow Creek Sioux Tribe. Kathie said she was familiar with them because she had worked there. They promote Education. They have a great program. The store receives a ton of winter clothes from people who move down her from the North and Eileen has been keeping them in the warehouse. Eileen feels that the store is doing so well that they can afford to box the clothes and pay for the postage to send them to this group. She just needs the Vestry to approve this. We are still waiting on Kingdom Restoration to give us a start date for the roof. I was told that they planned on starting May 17, but this did not happen.
